

Want to Help Save Wildlife? Join Our Statewide Wildlife Transporter Team!

Nebraska Wildlife Rehab has a dedicated team of volunteers statewide who rescue and retrieve injured, ill, and orphaned wildlife and help relay it to our Wildlife Center in eastern Nebraska.



Volunteers:

- Pick up wildlife from public rescuers, veterinary clinics, and in the field. Stabilize the animal(s) or seek veterinary attention for them in preparation for the journey, if needed.
- Drive one leg of the journey or the whole distance to our Wildlife Center, depending on your location and availability.
- A vehicle, valid driver's license, and a love of wildlife required!

Trainings will be held virtually and throughout the state in the spring and summer!

(Training locations will be determined based on volunteer interest)
